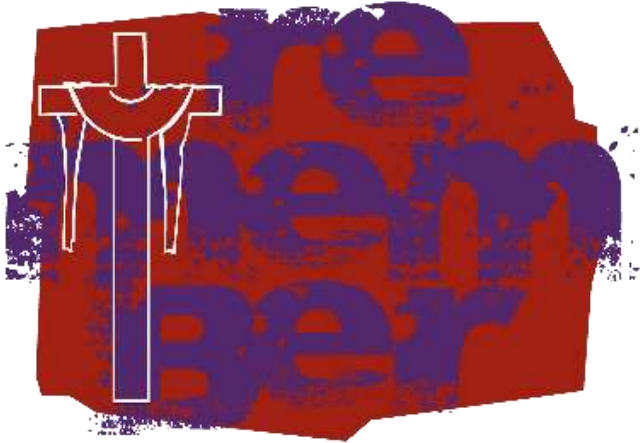

The Confession of Sins

*Jesus I will ponder now On your holy passion
With your Spirit me endow For such meditation
Grant that I in love and faith May the image cherish

Pastor: Let us confess our sins to God our Father.

People: O Lord our God, we have failed to live as Your baptized children, citizens of Your kingdom. We have not lived lives worthy of Your name. We have lived as though we are citizens of this sinful world, sinning against You in thought, word, and deed. Grant to us, Your sons and daughters, repentance and forgiveness. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.
