



P: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

C: **Amen.** (Spoken)

The Confession of Sins

*Come to Calv'ry's holy mountain, Sinners, ruined by the fall;
Here a pure and healing fountain Flows for you, for me, for
all, In a full, perpetual tide, Opened when our Savior died.*

Pastor: Lord God, we come before you as people who are parched with a thirst created by our sin. Left to ourselves, our sinful thirst would lead to death and hell. We come to You this day with repentant hearts, seeking the water that Christ gives. As people belonging to Christ, we take refuge

in the infinite mercy of God, our heavenly Father, seeking His grace for the sake of Christ, and saying: God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

People: Almighty God, have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins, and lead us to everlasting life. Amen.

Come in sorrow and contrition, Wounded, paralyzed, and blind;

Here the guilty, free remission, Here the troubled, peace may find.

Health this fountain will restore; They that drink shall thirst no more.

Pastor: "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." Upon this, your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God to all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.




