



The Confession of Sins

*Come to Calv'ry's holy mountain, Sinners, ruined by the fall;

Pastor: Lord God, we come before you as people who are parched with a thirst created by our sin. Left to ourselves,

As people belonging to Christ, we take refuge in the infinite mercy of God, our heavenly Father, seeking His grace for the sake of Christ, and saying: God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

People: Almighty God, have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins, and lead us to everlasting life. Amen.




