


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A Lent to Remember

The Confession of Sins

*Not all the blood of beasts
On Jewish altars slain
Could give the guilty conscience peace
Or wash away the stain.*

Pastor: As we live in this sinful world it is easy to take God for granted. We can look upon forgiveness as an entitlement

and believe it comes to us without repentance. How often do we lose sight of Jesus and our need for Him or take his presence for granted? For these and all our other sins we make confession to God.

Help us to see that while Your love is not an entitlement, it is still ours because of Your goodness and in Your love forgive us our sins.**

Pastor: God, our merciful Father, has forgiven all your sins. By his Son's innocent suffering and death, he has removed their punishment and restored to us the joy of salvation. May God give you peace as you live your life to his glory.

P: You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you descendants of Jacob, honor him!

C: Revere him, all you descendants of Israel!

C: he has not hidden his face from him but has listened to his cry for help.

P: From you comes the theme of my praise in the great assembly; before those who fear you I will fulfill my vows.

C: The poor will eat and be satisfied; those who seek the LORD will praise him— may your hearts live forever!
