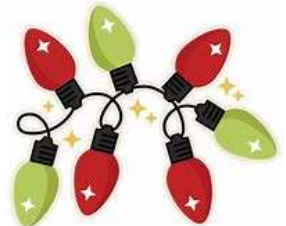


2019 Offering Envelopes are in the back of the Narthex. Please pick yours up when you leave if you haven't already.

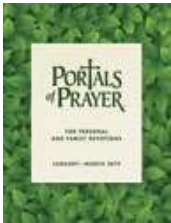
We will be serving at Immanuel for the Bread and Roses on December 27th. Donation slip is on the table in the narthex. So if you want to work or donate food just sign your name.



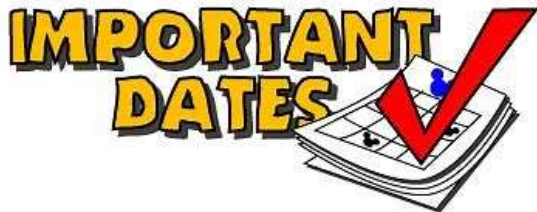
There are some Christmas lights lying on the table in the narthex. If anyone is interested in taking some or all of them please feel free.
